Classroom Management Strategies

- Have classroom rules clearly posted.
- Divide class time into tasks for specific lengths of time.
- Remind students of classroom expectations on a regular basis.
- Have an easily recognized signal to call for attention (turning off the lights, counting to five, etc.)
- Consistent application of classroom expectations.
- Extra tasks and/or perpetual tasks for students who finish their work before others.
- Offer praise when a student follows routines
- Fixed seating plan.
- Provide students with an agenda for the class' activities.
- Take attendance after students have started their class work.
